Scholarships from the Memorial Fund for Education are awarded by the Board of Deacons. The funds are made available from the monies accrued from the Memorial Fund for Education, comprised of memorial gifts to the church designated for this specific purpose.

Upon application, the scholarship may be granted to graduating High School Seniors who are members of the First Congregational Church of Lebanon and are, or have been, active participants in the life of the church. Matriculated Master of Divinity (MDiv) students who are also active members of our church may also submit an application for scholarship award.

Criteria used in determining scholarship recipients includes:

- 1. Church membership
- 2. Active Church participation
- 3. Completed application form

In addition:

- A. for a High School senior he / she needs to be seeking further studies or training in a designated institution
- B. for the Master of Divinity candidate, he/she needs to be a matriculated student

Applications:

- are available year round in the church foyer, or may also be downloaded directly from the Church website
- must be submitted to the Board of Deacons not later than April 30th

Individuals who are selected to receive a scholarship will be notified by the Board of Deacons, and should plan to be present at our church worship service on a designated Sunday in June (typically the second Sunday of the month) to receive their scholarship.
